Annual Meeting Held March 16

The Cornville Historical Society held its annual membership meeting on Wednesday afternoon, March 16, 2016. The business meeting included a welcome and progress report from



Diana Stipek, acting President. A plaque was presented to Judy Miller for her many contributions to the Historical Society, highlighting her ten years of as a board member, including serving as treasurer, secretary and president. Janet Cassagio presented the 2015-16 financial report; and members approved the 2016-17 budget.

Board members were then elected for the new year. Continuing board members for one more year are Cheryl Chamberlain, Veronica Moody and Cindy Snyder. Members re-elected for two-year terms are Janet Cassagio, Don Godard, Diana Stipek and Muffy Vallely. At a meeting immediately following the annual meeting, the board appointed two additional board members, Nita Rinehart and Don Welcome, to fill two remaining vacancies.

After the business meeting, Judy Miller and Janet Cassagio gave a PowerPoint presentation entitled, "Once Upon a Creek in Cornville." Judy provided an overview of Society history and accomplishments, including an update of the post office renovation project. Janet provided a history of Cornville settlement, highlighting early pioneer families and postmasters.

A question and answer period followed the presentation; and refreshments were served. As one final item of business, Dan Derrick won the floral centerpiece provided by Veronica Moody. A pleasant afternoon was had by all!


